


LTTA in Athens

Partners concentrated on Multiplier Events and other dissemination efforts that would take place in each partner country to raise awareness and provide information about the project's goals and deliverables.






The Digi4Equality E-learning Platform is completed!

Equal opportunities for women in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics will enhance gender equality and lead to an increase in the number of women employed in STEM fields.




